These are utilized by teachers and students in our computer labs, and the staff uses them for developing web content, email, and more."

Lenovo seemed to us to lead the market in terms of integrated things like cameras, biometric sensors, and more. Their docking stations and ability to expand are fantastic. And, so far, we have had the lowest support requirement of any device we have deployed with Lenovo."

Rugged Tools for the Classroom

The task of choosing the right device for an education setting is not easy. Kehayias selected Lenovo AIOs for their computer labs. He said, "The desire was not to have a computer tower on the floor anymore. First, it was cleaner, neater, and tidier, and it looks more impressive. Second, when we need to work on a machine it is a lot easier to unplug the keyboard, mouse, power cord, and Ethernet cable and just take it to go. We can't be in our school lab while the students are in there; it is much easier to grab an AIO, repair it, and get it redeployed."

Calvary Chapel utilizes more than AIOs. Kehayias elaborates, "We also use ThinkCentre Edge 91z desktops in our children's ministry building for touchscreen based check-in on the weekend. So, it's not just our staff and school needs, we are using Lenovo for our ministry too, which is really exciting." Kehayias continues, "We also use Lenovo ThinkPad W510 notebooks for our engineering staff; they build software, websites, and work with graphics. I use a ThinkPad W530 notebook today and have used a W510 and W520 previously. Most of our staff runs T4 Series notebooks."

Kehavias' enthusiasm for Lenovo does not go unnoticed at Calvary Chapel. When asked to explain why, he recalls a day when he accidentally spilled water onto the keyboard of his beloved Lenovo notebook.
